Son's death inspires his mother's crusade

Nolan Moi was a typical 19-year-old: He delivered pizzas, played video games, watched TV and occasionally smoked pot.

Why someone would put a bullet into the back of his head is a mystery that has baffled Cincinnati police.

Moi's mother, Lucy Logan, believes someone knows who pulled the trigger and has put up a \$10,000 reward for information. She's also formed a network of parents of children whose murders have gone unsolved, hoping to solicit donations from the public to put up reward money for information about the killers.

"I want to convince people to invest in getting murderers off the street," said Logan, who founded Who Killed Our Kids shortly after her son was killed in the early on March 11.

Crimestoppers already offers up to \$1,000 for tips; Logan is hoping, with donations, that she can increase that amount by several thousand dollars for information connected to homicides.

"Spending \$3,000 or \$5,000 to lock up a murderer is very cheap," she said. "Some of these people have murdered more than one person, or could go on to kill someone else. We need to get them off the streets."

Logan also is spearheading an effort to put up wanted posters -- but, because police have no suspects, they will feature the victims, not the alleged killers. "We want to put out there on the street the names, pictures, location and times of these unsolved murders," Logan said. "These pictures are already out there, on Web sites and on television and in newspapers -- . We have to put these pictures out on the street -- in storefronts, in the courthouse, in the jails, where people who might know something could come forward in the hope of getting some money or getting cut a break."

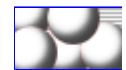
