## Reward offered for clues in death

*The friends and family of a young man found shot to death in his Madisonville apartment building are hoping a \$10,000 reward will help solve a two-month-old murder mystery - one with no known motive, witnesses or suspects.*

*Since 19-year-old Nolan Moi was killed March 11 in his apartment at 4412 Erie Ave., there have been 17 more homicides in the city, including the much-publicized slaying of a 911 operator, found dead in her Westwood home April 15.*

*In the meantime, Moi's case has received little media attention, and police are still hoping for their first break in the case.*

*"They have no leads. They have no motive. They have no suspects. No one has come forward with any information. The detectives can't tell me why he was killed," said Moi's mother, Lucy Logan .*

*Police spokesman Lt. Kurt Byrd said police are still at square one in the investigation.*

*According to Logan, Moi was killed between 1:30 and 4:30 a.m. March 11. He was shot to death, though two roommates sleeping in the apartment at the time said they didn't hear anything, Logan said.*

*"He'd just bought a new computer ... and he was playing with it with his friends," Logan said. "His friends went home around 1:30 or 2 and the roommates went to bed, but he stayed up to keep playing with his computer game."*

*The roommates woke up the next morning, saw him lying at the bottom of the staircase and called the fire department, thinking he'd fallen, according to police reports.*

*There were no signs of forced entry into the apartment, and nothing was apparently stolen, Logan said. She said it wouldn't have been unusual for her son to leave his door unlocked - or to open the door for someone who said he needed help.*

*"He'd help anybody, any time. He was a real pleasant kid, and very mature for a 19-year-old. If anyone needed help, he'd help them," Logan said. "He was that kind of person."*

*Moi was a graduate of the School for Creative and Performing Arts in Over-the-Rhine.*

He was a pizza delivery man for Mio's in Oakley and sometimes worked with his father, an electrician. He played bass guitar for two local punk-rock bands: Running for Daylight and, more recently, The Spitz.

"He was a nice kid. He didn't hang out, he didn't go to bars, he wasn't involved with drugs. He wasn't the type to go out and carouse with people all night long," Logan said.

"He was just a real easy-going guy," said Steve Arend of Mount Washington, a friend of Moi's for several years and a co-worker at the pizzeria.

"He was the kind of guy that would never be down, always positive.

"I don't know anybody who could hate a guy like him."

The \$10,000 reward being offered by Logan and other relatives and friends for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for Moi's death is in addition to the \$1,000 already offered by Crimestoppers, she said.

"We're hoping for any kind of information at all. Anyone who saw anything that night, anything questionable. Just think about that night. Maybe you saw something at 2:30 or 3 o'clock in the morning on Erie Avenue on March 11," she said.

"We're going to be relentless. We are not going to sleep. We are going to keep going until we find out what happened and who did this," Logan said.
